Quakers have a longstanding concern for living sustainably and justly which arise from our testimonies to simplicity, integrity, truth and peace.

Quakers share a way of life, rather than a set of beliefs, seeking to experience God directly within ourselves, and in our relationships with others and the world around us.

We want to make sure our use of natural resources is sustainable. Quakers try to live simply and to find space for the things that really matter: the people around us, the natural world, and our experience of stillness.

In 2011 Quakers in Britain made a commitment to become a low-carbon, sustainable community. We are working to turn climate emergency declarations into reality and campaigning for energy justice and climate action.

We are invited to show our care for the climate during February 2020 by joining in with The Climate Coalition's Show the Love campaign.

The world has warmed to an average of 1 degrees C above pre-industrial temperatures. We must limit the warming of our world to 1.5 degrees C to protect the people, places and lives we love from the worst effects of climate change.

Quakers have always been part of the wider climate movement, speaking truth to power, holding decision makers to account, and sharing our testimonies on simple living. Conversation leads to action. Ways to #ShowTheLove

Ever since the start of Show the Love, communities across the UK have demonstrated year-on-year that beautiful things are possible when people work together. Things may look a bit different this year, but you can still show the love! Here are some ways you can get involved:

COMMIT TO PRAY

For our world and all those whose lives are currently impacted by climate change, and for guidance for our leaders as they make decisions to end the country's contribution to climate change.

ASK YOUR MP TO JOIN YOU IN TAKING CLIMATE ACTION

This year, The Climate Coalition is asking us to encourage our MPs to #ShowTheLove for a cleaner, greener future. If you craft a green heart, save one for your MP and send it along with the postcard included at the end of this guide.

MAKE, WEAR AND SHARE A GREEN HEART TO START CONVERSATIONS ABOUT CLIMATE CHANGE

CREATE A GREEN HEART DISPLAY

This February, connect with others in your area such as community groups and local faith communities. Organise an online talk about why you care about climate change, the work you are doing to tackle climate change, and explore how you can work together to help create a cleaner, greener future this year.

Our declaration brings together people from all walks of life with businesses, community groups, MPs, local decision makers to send a strong and unified message that #TheTimeIsNow to take urgent action to protect what we love from the climate crisis.

We want to reach one million voices before the UN Climate Summit. Encourage your congregation to add their name to the declaration at thetimeisnow.uk, and send a postcard to your MP to ask them to commit to #ShowTheLove by championing climate action.



STEP 1

Add your name to the declaration at thetimeisnow.uk - you can sign up as an individual and as a community too.



STEP 2

Fill in the postcard and add a bit about why you've signed the declaration so your MP knows why you care about climate action.



STEP 3

Fold your postcard, attach a crafted green heart if you've made one.



STEP 4

Pop the postcard in an envelope and send it your MP. You can find their constituency surgery address at members.parliament.uk or alternatively send it to (addressed to them) to House of Commons, London, SW1A 0AA.



STEP 5

Keep an eye out for their response.
